<b>August</b>	Anemones, Butterfly Bush, Chrysanthemums, Franklin Tree, Hardy Begonia, Herbs, Phlox, Roses, Rose of Sharon, Rudbeckia, Salvias, Scholar Tree, Sourwood
<b>September</b>	Asters, Chrysanthemums, Franklin Tree, Goldenrod, Monkshood, Roses, Salvias, Sedums
<b>October</b>	Asters, Fall Leaves, Roses, Monkshood, Trifoliolate Orange
<b>November/ December</b>	Heath, Heather, Hollies, Winterberry, Witch Hazel
