Fall Adult Education Workshops - 2009

Introduction to Plant Propagation

This course will provide a look at the science of plant propagation. We will examine vegetative reproduction as well as seed propagation. We will also look at the tools and techniques used to graft, take cuttings, layer and so forth. We will discuss some of the genetics of plant reproduction to include the production of F₁ Hybrids. The course will run for two evenings. This course will be offered on Tuesday September 29 and Thursday October 1 from 7PM to 9 PM in the Education Center \$40 Members, \$45 Nonmembers. Minimum number of students is 5, maximum is 25.

Horticultural Techniques

This class will be an expansion of the Sharpening Your Tools class. We will discuss and demonstrate the use of many of the standard horticultural hand and power tools. Additionally, pruning techniques and materials and methods to move small plants will be taught. Irrigation, mulching and other topics will be discussed. Putting the garden to bed for the winter will be a main focus. This course will run for two evenings. This course will be offered Tuesday October 13 and Thursday October 15 from 7PM to 9PM in the Education Center. \$40 Members, \$45 Nonmembers. Minimum number of students is 5, maximum is 25.

Introduction to Organic Gardening

With the introduction of many invasive species of insects and weeds, organic gardening is becoming a much more difficult endeavor to undertake. Concepts of developing a good organic soil, composting, the use of compost teas, pest control and plant selection will be taught. This course will run for two evenings. This course will be offered Tuesday, November 17 and Thursday November 19 from 7PM to 9PM in the Education Center. \$40 Members, \$45 Nonmembers. Minimum number of students is 5, maximum is 25.
