The Reeves-Reed Arboretum is a historic country estate where the house and gardens represent design trends from the late 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> centuries. In 1974, with public and private funds, the estate was converted into an arboretum which focuses on horticultural and environmental education of the formal gardens, glacial bowl, woodlands, native wetlands, and the former estate.

Reeves-Reed Arboretum is a perfect backdrop for photography including weddings and family portraits. A permit is required. Contact the office at 908.273.8787 to schedule with the date and time for your photography session. A permit is required. We ask for a \$75 donation. The permit entitles the photographer to utilize the Arboretum only on the date and during the time mentioned. Should there be a change in time or date, please contact the office.

The grounds and formal gardens of the Arboretum are open to the public, but because it is not publicly funded the cost of keeping the grounds beautiful is borne by private contributions.

### Guidelines

- Please be advised that **no alcoholic beverages are allowed** on the property at any time.
- Enjoy walking through the grounds while staying on the pathways and grass leaving all plants, flowers, rocks and natural objects as you found them.
- We ask that you park cars and limousines in appropriate spaces and not block the driveway.
- Several wedding parties will often be present at the same time. Space should be made for everyone.
- Properly dispose of all trash and recyclables in the bins provided.
- Be courteous, respect other visitors and enjoy this haven in Summit.
