*For families with children ages 6 and up*

Help scientists at Cornell's Lab of Ornithology document winter bird populations in our area. The program will begin inside with a lesson on bird identification, and will then continue outside where we will identify and count the number of birds seen in several areas at the Arboretum. The Great Backyard Bird Count is a 4-day event so participants are encouraged to continue the count in their own back yards. Registration is not required.
